Established in October 2019, Nami Energy is a Vietnam-based clean energy developer focused on rooftop solar (RTS) solutions for commercial and industrial (C&I) customers, offering end-to-end services, from development and financing to long-term operations. As of December 2025, Nami had commissioned 12 rooftop solar projects with a combined installed capacity of 22.9 MWp, supporting Vietnam's clean energy transition by helping businesses reduce fossil fuel use and energy costs. Nami has since expanded its footprint from southern to northern Vietnam and is targeting 260 MWp by the end of 2034.

Value Creation

Nami integrates a robust ESG management system (ESGMS) into its operations to ensure alignment with national and international standards, including IFC Performance Standards. This approach strengthens risk management across environmental, social, and governance factors while fostering responsible practices and delivering sustainable long-term value.

By embedding ESG at the core, Nami not only drives operational excellence but also enhances its credibility with investors, positioning the company strongly for future fundraising.

Technical Assistance Activities

Australian Development Investments' Technical Assistance (TA) supported Nami in strengthening its organisational and systems capacities, while embedding best-practice ESG standards across its operations. Key initiatives include:



Development of the ESGMS Manual

Creation of a comprehensive manual outlining all components of the Environmental and Social Management System, including anti-sexual harassment policies and the integration of corporate ESG standards.



Development of Supporting Documents

Preparation of procedures, plans, mechanisms, tools, and policies to guide and improve environmental and social performance.



ESG Management System Training

Delivery of training to strengthen organisational understanding and application of ESG requirements, including climate-related aspects.




Social Safeguarding Training

Provision of training focused on core social safeguarding principles and implementation practices.

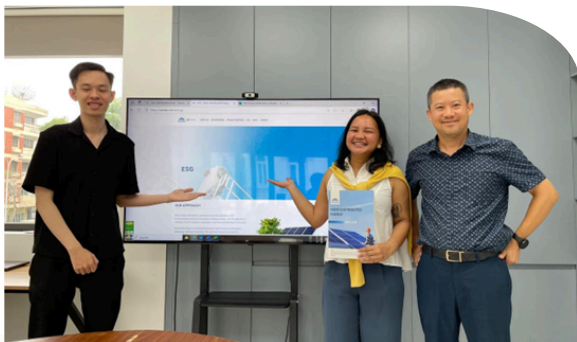
Technical Assistance Results

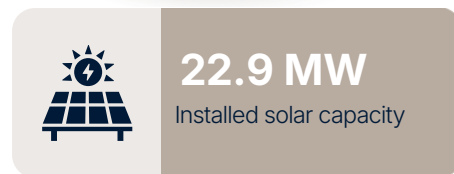
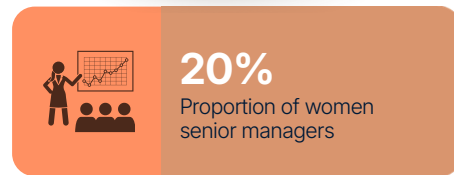
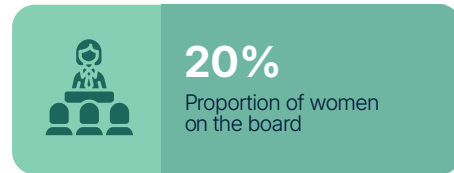


Showcase of dedicated ESG page on Nami Energy website
